THAWING:

- 1. Allow container to reach room temperature before use.
- 2. After removing from the freezer, set the syringes to stand vertically while thawing.
- DO NOT open the container before contents reach 25°C temperature. Any moisture that collects on the thawed container should be removed prior to opening the container.
- 4. DO NOT re-freeze. Once thawed to 25°C, the adhesive should not be re-frozen.

- 1. LOCTITE ABLESTIK GA4 adhesive is designed for stencil/screen printing, pin transfer, dot dispensing or syringe dispensing.
- 2. Dispense the desired amount of material and place die into deposit using downward force to achieve desired bondline.
